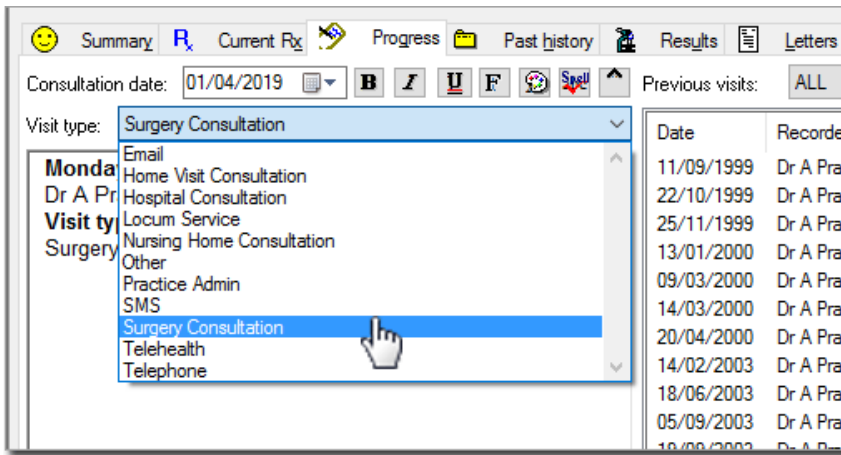

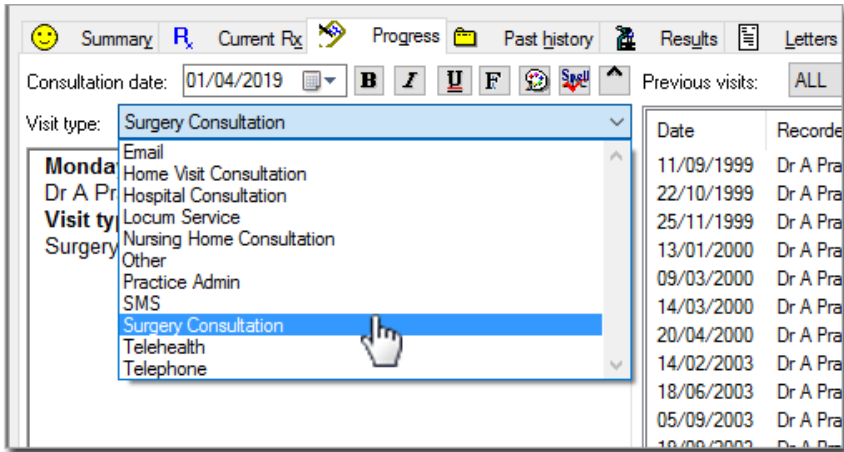

Alternative Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island adult health checks, and alternative chronic disease management plans, both refer to clinical activities recorded by clinicians outside of the practice. It is not possible to record these instances within MedicalDirector Clinical.

'Mothers' refers to female patients who have recorded an antenatal care visit, regardless of whether they gave birth during the year

'Individual mothers who have attended at least one routine antenatal care visit' is recorded within OCHREStreams as 'Individual mothers who have attended at least one routine antenatal care visit during the period'.

'Routine antenatal care visits by mothers' is recorded within OCHREStreams as 'Routine ANC visits by mothers during the period'.
